1553 –Shambles square was built. 1761 – The industrial Revolution.


1800 - Manchester acquired the nickname Cottonopolis during the early century owing to its many textile factories.

Laurence Stephen Lowry was an English artist. His drawings and paintings mainly depict Manchester, Lancashire as well as Salford and its vicinity. Lowry is famous for painting scenes of life in the industrial districts of North West of England in the mid-20th century.



Beetham Tower is a 47-storey skyscraper in Manchester. It is 168.87 metres high and was completed in 2006. It is used as a hotel, a residence and offices. Beetham Tower is home to the Manchester Hilton Hotel, 219 luxury apartments and 16 penthouses.





He developed a distinctive style of painting and is best known for his urban landscapes with human figures, often referred to as "matchstick men".



Manchester Town Hall is a Victorian, Neo-gothic municipal building in Manchester, built in 1968. Manchester Central Library is the headquarters of the city's library and information service in Manchester. Facing St Peter's Square, it was designed by E.Vincent Harris and constructed between 1930 and 1934. It has a distinct round shape based on a Roman building.
